Background

The Sierra Leone Digital Transformation Project (SLDTP) is a five-year International Development Association (IDA)-funded project supported with a US\$50 million grant. The project's main implementing agency is the Ministry of Information and Communications (MIC). The proposed Project Development Objective (PDO) is to expand access to broadband internet, enhance digital skills and improve government capacity to deliver public services digitally. The SLDTP proposes four integrated and mutually reinforcing components, with a fifth component dedicated to contingent response to future emergencies (*Contingent Emergency Response Component, CERC*). The Project wishes to invite applications from suitable and qualified Sierra Leoneans for the position of **Monitoring and Evaluation Specialist.**
